FROM OUR PASTOR


Dear Parishioners,

By now, many people know that Deacon Dennis covered for me when I was at St. Gregory one Sunday morning because I ended it up at the emergency room. I had a painful Crohn's episode and was brought there around 6:30 AM. I was diagnosed with Crohn's when I was 27 years old after spending a few days in the hospital, but since that time it has been fairly quiet .I want to keep everyone updated and help explain some of the reasons why I may need to be absent from parish activities. Currently, I am discussing with my doctor the different medications that are available for a maintenance program. I am sure that after a few adjustments the Crohn's will be back under full control as it has been in the past.

I start the Adult Education Series this Monday at Holy Martyrs at 6:30 pm. It is following the outline of the Fr. Robert Barron's Catholicism DVD program. I want to take it slower and go deeper into each of the subjects he raises. It is my hope that many of you are looking for something challenging that is more than an introduction. Please consider spending some time with me on Monday nights.

We are looking to update the audio/visual capabilities here in the parish. We are getting quotes for both Holy Martyrs and Sacred Heart in order to make it easier to show movies and internet videos like our Formed Program using the sound system in the parish halls. Contemporary forms of education, faith formation and social gatherings are greatly advanced when we have the right equipment to use. We are very fortunate to have a gifts from 2 families who want to make this happen in the parish so it will not impact our budget. Hopefully it will impact our faith though.
