Yes...we have taken action...  
 ~ Our Parish transferred funds to our sister parish of Sacre-Coeur de Meyer for food, sanitation, and anti-cholera supplies. Father Bertrand Dieuville said that these were most critical. The Meyer Parish will create food kits for the elderly, the sick people and the children and deliver them. On October 17, Father stated that the parish neighborhood groups, les fraternités, had initiated this plan and other measures would follow.  
 ~ The Cyvadier Parish Center and the Sisters who feed and minister to local children and families were given additional funds to meet greater needs.  
 ~ Emergency support to the Marbial Church and Father Phanel Chery. Communication with this remote community of approximately 60,000 people has been difficult and the road was cut off for a period. Father reported no deaths, some roofs blowing off houses, but most importantly all crops and livestock washed away. Funds were transferred to the parish bank account and will be used for food and emergency supplies.  
 Yes...we can do these things...  
 ....because parishioners have been generous, steadfast in support for our Haitian friends.  
 ....because we had a reserve of funds for Haiti in the expectation of church and rectory repairs. Today - the need is saving lives.  
 . ....because you donated almost \$7000 last weekend for the monthly door collection.  
 ....because we expect that very difficult conditions will persist for a long, long time.  
 Yes...we thank you for caring - **in this year of "Mercy,"**  
 Yes...we pray for the long-suffering, but resilient people of Haiti.
