A note from Fr. Dan...

The bell tower at Sacred Heart Church is a proud and enduring symbol of our Catholic faith. It stood beside Main Street in Yarmouth long before many of the surrounding buildings appeared. While it has withstood many winter storms and summer squalls, the tower is now in serious need of repair. Over time, water has entered the tower causing water damage to the floor the bell rests upon and the floors below.

Repairs to the tower are estimated to cost \$19,000 and will be done in three stages. The floor will be jacked up to reverse the sagging and two additional heavy wooden beams will be added to support this floor and prevent future sagging. The damaged membrane on the floor will be replaced with a new membrane which will be raised to allow proper draining of any water that enters the tower. Rotting sections of the crib will also be replaced. Finally, the louvers will be repaired and backing will be added as an additional safeguard to prevent water entry in the future.

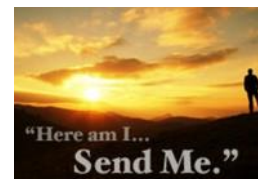
CATHOLIC FAMILY LIFE**Jan 14 - God is calling ME?**
