There are three ways for you to participate:

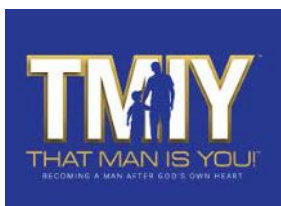
1. In your home as a family or individual

Habitat for Humanity - The Parish supported the recent Good Friday Walk in raising funds for building homes for families who qualify. The program has undertaken a major building project in Scarborough in recent years. A new effort is under consideration for Habitat homes in Falmouth. The Good Friday Walk took place in Cumberland, North Yarmouth and Yarmouth with designated routes between the towns for people walking 5 - 10 and 20 mile treks. Other people pledged money and it raised about \$15,000 for the program. In addition, the Cumberland middle school group undertook its own "walk" and raised \$6600. POTHE supplied food and beverages for one of the way stations and assisted at Greely Road in welcoming and registering the walkers.

The next event for Habitat is the Habitat 5K Run in Falmouth on Saturday, May 5. We hope that parishioners will again support by volunteering and offering food.

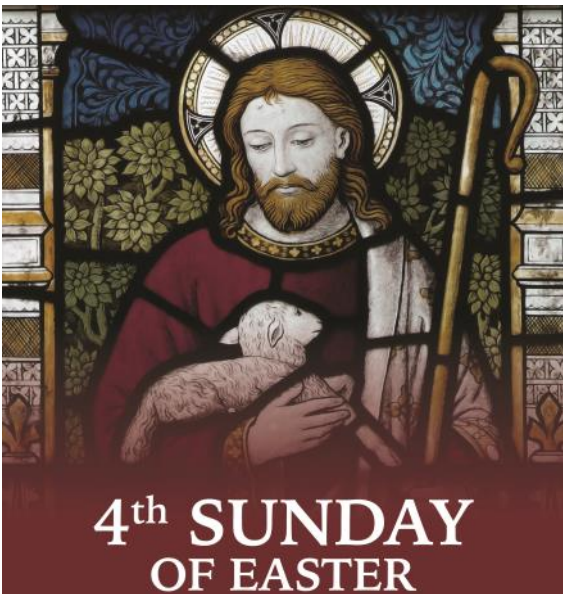
