- Would you like to grow in your relationship with the Holy Spirit?
- Do you know someone who has fallen away from the Catholic Church ... perhaps a friend, a family member, or a co-worker, and you want reach them, but you just don't know how to?

Meet with members of your parish family weekly for fourteen weeks this spring and summer to deepen your relationship with the Holy Spirit through a video based study called THE WILD GOOSE. After watching the video we will have time for discussion, reflection, and prayer. Sessions at Holy Martyrs will also include a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. The Wild Goose—a term the ancient Celts had for the Holy Spirit—is a simple attempt to invite Catholic Christians into a more profound life-giving relationship with the Holy Spirit.

Our Parish wide study will begin the week of May 6 and run for 14 weeks. The sessions are all independent, so you can come to watch all, a few or even just one. Group sessions will be held at Holy Martyrs on Monday evenings and at St Jude on Sunday mornings and Thursday afternoons. There will also be home groups and we will provide materials for you to watch as a family or individual.

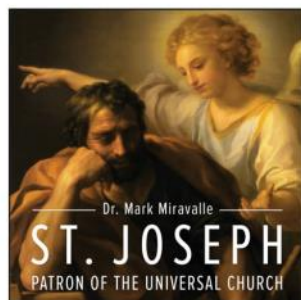
