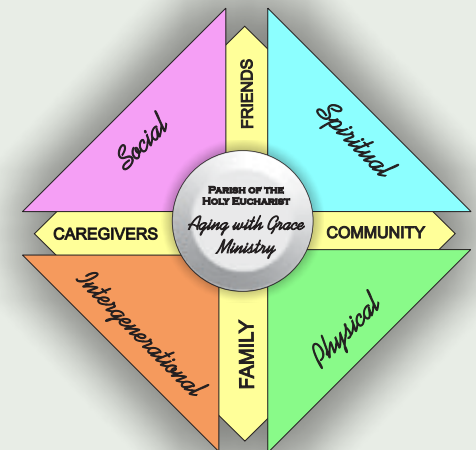

Included are those living alone who would enjoy being contacted by a parishioner and may also include neighbors who aren't members of the parish. In speaking with the homebound, our ministers will determine a) if they would like to have a Eucharistic Minister bring them Communion; b) if they would like to speak with a priest; c) additional assistance we might coordinate for them; and d) the frequency with which they would like to be contacted.
